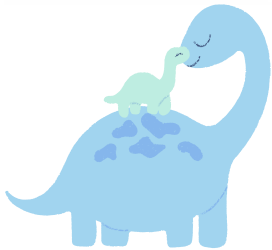

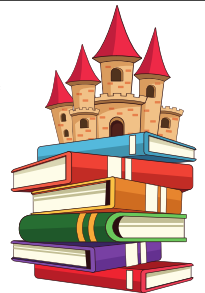

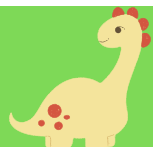


Halloween Storytime
