

Check Out a Public Library Book for Kindle

You can borrow Kindle books from your local library's website, and, with the click of a button, have them delivered to your registered Kindle device or free reading app.

Instructions:

1. Visit the ER Public Library website at eastrockawaylibrary.org
2. Click on the “**E-BOOKS**” tab. Click on “**Overdrive**”
3. Click **Sign In** located to the right in the black strip at the top of the page.
4. Select **East Rockaway Public Library** (or your home library) from the dropdown menu.
5. Enter the 14 digits of your library barcode.
6. Click **Sign in**.
7. Search for a title to download. (Hint: If you click on “**Advanced Search**” go to the **Format** drop-down menu and select **Kindle Book**. This will limit your search to only Kindle titles. You can also click the “**show only available copies**” button if you only want to see copies that are available immediately.)

Some titles by certain publishers cannot be downloaded wirelessly so be aware of the fact that these titles have to be downloaded through a **USB connection**. For help doing this click on the **Digital Help** link in the upper right hand corner of the screen. Then click **OverDrive Help** and follow the link for Kindle.

NOTE: If the book icon in the upper right corner of the book cover is black, the book is available. If it is gray, you have to place a request for the title.

8. Click on the book that you want to borrow.
9. Click **Borrow**.
10. Click on the **arrow** in the **Download** box. Select **Kindle Book**.
11. Click **Confirm & Download**. This will open up your browser to Amazon.com.
12. Click on **Get Library Book**. Sign into your Amazon account.
13. Under **Deliver to:** select **Your Name's Kindle** OR **Transfer via Computer** for USB titles.
14. Your book will be delivered to your device through your Wi-Fi connection. You **DO NOT HAVE TO CLICK THE DOWNLOAD BUTTON** unless you are transferring the book through a USB connection.

FOR BOOKS DOWNLOADED THROUGH USB ONLY!

Once the file has been saved, connect your Kindle to your computer using a USB cable.

Connecting your Kindle Keyboard to your computer:

1. Plug the larger end of a USB cable into an available USB port or a powered USB hub connected to your computer.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to the micro-USB port on the bottom of your Kindle device.

When connected to your computer, your Kindle will go into USB drive mode and its battery will be recharged by the computer. Your wireless service is temporarily shut off and you will not receive any of your subscriptions while in this mode. Also, your Kindle device is not usable as a reading device while you are in USB drive mode, but will return right to where you were once you safely eject the Kindle device from your computer.

Transferring content to your Kindle Keyboard:

1. Once you've connected your Kindle to a computer using a USB cable, your Kindle will appear in the same location as external USB drives usually appear. For Windows users, this is typically in the "Computer" or "My Computer" menu. For Mac users, the drive will appear on the desktop.
2. Open the Kindle drive. You will see several folders inside, one of which will be named "documents." This is the folder you will move the downloaded file into.
3. Locate the downloaded file and copy it into the documents folder. You can generally copy files by clicking and dragging the file to the folder. (If you are not sure where you saved the file check Documents – Downloads)
4. Safely eject your Kindle device from your computer from the task bar and unplug the USB cable. Your content will appear on the Home screen.
